

**DONOR-RECIPIENT AGREEMENT
ON INSEMINATION**

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between Scott Allen Liming, hereinafter "Donor", and Kelly Kathleen Mullen, hereinafter "Recipient", who may also be referred to herein as "the parties".

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises of each other, DONOR and RECIPIENT agree as follows:

1. Each clause of this Agreement is separate and divisible from the others and should a Court refuse to enforce one or more clauses of this Agreement, the others are still valid and in full force.
2. DONOR has agreed to provide his semen to RECIPIENT for the purpose of alternative insemination. The parties have further agreed that the DONOR's semen may be frozen at the time of the donation and may be used by the RECIPIENT at a subsequent time. This Agreement is to apply to all semen already donated as well as to any future donations.
3. In exchange, RECIPIENT has agreed to pay the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars to DONOR each and every time he makes a semen donation.
4. RECIPIENT acknowledges that she is unmarried and has never married. DONOR acknowledges that he is unmarried and has never married.
5. Each party acknowledges and agrees that RECIPIENT will use the donated semen to attempt to become pregnant and will continue to use such donations until conception occurs.
6. Each party acknowledges and agrees that the DONOR is providing his semen for the purposes of said alternative insemination and does so with the clear understanding that he will not demand, request, or compel any guardianship, custody, or visitation rights with any child(ren) born from the alternative insemination procedure. Further DONOR acknowledges that he fully understands that he would have no parental rights whatsoever with said child(ren). This Agreement, however, shall not prevent RECIPIENT from making any voluntary guardianship, custody, or visitation agreements she may wish to enter into with DONOR.
7. Each party acknowledges and agrees that RECIPIENT, through this Agreement, has relinquished any and all rights she might otherwise have to hold DONOR legally, financially, or emotionally responsible for any child(ren) conceived through the alternative insemination contemplated herein.

8. Each party acknowledges and agrees that the sole authority to name any child(ren) conceived through the alternative insemination contemplated herein shall rest with the RECIPIENT.

9. Each party acknowledges and agrees that DONOR shall be listed as "father" on the birth certificate of any child(ren) conceived through the alternative insemination contemplated herein.

10. Each party covenants and agrees that, in light of the expectations of each party as stated above, RECIPIENT shall have absolute authority and power to a) appoint a Testamentary Guardian for any child(ren) conceived through the alternative insemination contemplated herein; b) appoint an Agent through a Power of Attorney to act in her stead in the financial or healthcare interest(s) of any child(ren) conceived through the alternative insemination contemplated herein; and c) consent to the adoption of any child(ren) conceived through the alternative insemination contemplated herein by her life partner.

11. Each party covenants and agrees that, in light of the expectations of each party as stated above, RECIPIENT shall have absolute authority and power to act with sole discretion as to all legal, financial, medical and emotion needs of any child(ren) conceived through the alternative insemination contemplated herein.

12. Each party acknowledges and agrees that the relinquishment of all rights, as stated above, is final and irrevocable. DONOR further understands that his waivers shall prohibit any action for custody, guardianship, or visitation in any future situation, including in the event of the RECIPIENT's death or disability, unless any child is no longer in the custody of DONOR or DONOR's partner, Michele Hobbs, in which case DONOR may petition a court for custody, guardianship, or visitation. Nothing herein, however, shall prevent the RECIPIENT from making a voluntary designation in a Last Will and Testament or other document of the DONOR as a testamentary guardian, should she so chose.

13. Each party agrees and covenants that any dispute pertaining to this Agreement shall be submitted to binding arbitration before the American Arbitration Association, Hamilton County, Ohio, or to a private arbitrator on whom the parties may agree.

14. Each party acknowledges and agrees that he or she has signed this Agreement voluntarily, of his or her own choice, without duress of any kind whatsoever.

15. The parties acknowledge and agree that Scott E. Knox, Esq., an attorney of the State of Ohio, has drafted this Agreement and has represented the Recipient in respect to this Agreement, and that Keith Knight, Esq., an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Georgia, has

represented the Donor in respect to this Agreement,

16. Each party acknowledges and agrees that any amendments to this Agreement shall be made in writing and signed by both parties.

17. This Agreement shall be construed under the Laws of the State of Ohio and the parties hereto agree and consent to the jurisdiction and venue in the Domestic Relations Court of Hamilton County, Ohio.

18. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties. There are no promises, understandings or representations between the parties other than those expressly set forth herein.
